

# HYPERTHYROIDISM IN CATS

Older cats can often have an overactive thyroid gland.

Signs of the condition include:

- Weight loss
- Increased activity and restlessness
- Unkempt appearance
- Increased appetite
- Fast heart rate
- Increased thirst
  - Vomiting
  - Diarrhoea

If you think your cat might be affected, please speak to your local vet.

Radioiodine treatment is often the preferred method of treating this common condition in cats.
